This term in our Year 9 PSHE curriculum we will continue building on our RSE lessons from Year 7 and Year 8 to provide more detailed education on contraception, choices and consequences including unplanned pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases. After Christmas we will be spending some lessons looking at dementia. We will be looking at the signs and symptoms, the impact on all those involved and what we can do to help and support a dementia patient.

Towards the end of the academic year we will be looking at SMART targets and helping to prepare the students for KS4.
