Dear Parents/Carers

In PSHE as part of our KS4 RSE scheme of work we will be building on the teaching of the earlier years and address some of the more difficult and complex issues such as making safe choices, domestic abuse, consent, FGM and honour-based abuse. We will also address some of the challenges young people face including revenge porn, sexting, sexual orientation, up skirting, gambling and bullying as stated in the legal framework.

We will be seeking to ensure that young people understand the seriousness and consequences of some of these issues and to enable students to be aware of their rights and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

Topics will also cover society today and will look at diversity, prejudice and discrimination.

Careers support will be given throughout Year 11 in relation to further education / apprenticeship application forms as well as writing CV's and personal statements. Support will be given with revision techniques and exam stress.

Lessons in Year 11 also help students for when they leave school such as voting, money and banking including taxes and insurance and what a payslip looks like. We also look at how to stay safe online and in particular look at identity theft.
