





### **APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK**

#### STUDENT/TRAINEE NURSING ASSOCIATE

The **Student Nursing Associate (SNA)** (formerly known as Trainee Nursing Associate) is an excellent way to advance a career in nursing. To meet the entry requirements candidates must have completed a year as a Band 2 Healthcare Assistant/Support Worker or as a Level 2 Apprentice Healthcare Assistant and have received the Care Certificate. The apprenticeship is typically a two-year program during which students work while learning on the job. They are required to complete both academic and practical components. While Nursing Associates are not registered nurses, they can perform many nursing tasks and play a vital role in patient care. Having completed this apprenticeship however students can then go on to train to become a registered nurse.

# **CAREER OF THE WEEK**

#### **CLINICAL PHOTOGRAPHY**

A career in **clinical photography** combines the fields of healthcare and photography to document medical conditions, surgeries, research, and other healthcare-related activities. **Clinical photographers** play a crucial role in healthcare by capturing high-quality images and videos for various purposes, including patient records, education, research, and presentations. In order to get into such a career you will need to be proficient in photography with a knowledge of camera equipment, have precise and accurate attention to detail. Good communication skills are vital too as you will work closely with other medical professionals and patients. Challenges on the job may be that working in medical environments can often be emotionally challenging and that you will need to take great care to maintain patient privacy - complying to legislation such as GDPR.
