Dear Parents/Carers.

Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award

Your child has the opportunity to apply for a place on a very popular Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme which will commence from December this year.

The Bronze programme has 4 sections: Volunteering, Physical, Skill and Expedition. To be successful, every participant must complete a block of work of at least 3 months' duration in voluntary work, in a physical exercise activity and in developing a skill. One of these areas also needs to extend to a total duration of 6 months. In addition, they must plan and train for a 2-day (possibly 1 night) expedition, which they will carry out in the summer of 2024. At Barnwood Park we will provide the training and opportunities to complete the expedition; however, it will be your child's individual responsibility to complete the other three sections and anyone who has not started each section by the Easter break 2024 will not qualify for the expedition.

Students who complete their Physical, Skill and Volunteering sections will receive an eCertificate of Achievement directly from the Duke of Edinburgh's Award scheme once these sections are complete.

One important aspect of the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme is for participants to be committed and well organised throughout the year. During term time there will be regular meetings after school, on a Friday, together with additional skills days taking place at weekends. They must also successfully complete an expedition weekend, dates and further information will be communicated in Term 4. Before being able to attend the assessed expedition in the summer term, a participant must complete a series of practical training sessions run throughout the academic year.

There is a charge of £80 for the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award which enrols every participant on to the programme; each participant will receive a welcome pack and an online account. It also covers the following expenses: Operating License Fee, Expedition training and assessment including some equipment use and Badges and Certificates.

The cost does not include food for the expedition weekends or personal equipment. All participants must provide their own walking boots, a full set of waterproofs and a large capacity (65 litres) rucksack. The school will provide stoves, fuel, and tents, if required. A full kit list will be provided during Term 4.

We will be in touch early in Term 4 with your expedition letter, drop off and pick up times and venues. We are completely aware that this Award will be slightly different and there may be barriers to some of the sections. Please be assured that these alterations are in line with the recent changes to the Expedition Section made by the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme and will make sure that, on completion, you gain your full Bronze Award.

If your child would like to participate in the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award, they must complete and return the attached form along with your deposit of £40, you can pay via the ScoPay Online Payment system which can be accessed from the school website. Alternatively, cash or cheque payable to Barnwood Park School by Friday 13th October 2023. The attached slip must be completed and returned indicating how you are paying and put in the blue box. (*Please note that once your child has registered for the Award it will not be possible to reimburse the registration fee if they then change their mind as we will send the fee off immediately to register for the scheme).* The final payment of £40 is due by Friday 15th March 2024.
