Thanks to Mrs Fitzgerald-Johnson for last week's department spotlight on English. This week, we have Ms Patel to tell us all about what is happening in the Humanities:

So far, this term has been a busy one with KS3 students diving into a rich variety of topics across the Humanities subjects. We have been impressed with the hard work, effort and participation students have shown across Geography, History and Religious Studies.

The Year 7's have been sharpening their map reading skills in Geography; Exploring how Britain has changed since Year 0 in History; and have started to examine religious beliefs and the core Christian belief of The Trinity in Religious Studies.

Year 8 geographers have been exploring the causes and consequences of climate change; uncovered Gloucester's layered past in History lessons; and begun to investigate core Islamic beliefs in Religious Studies.

And in Year 9, geographers have traced the Middle East's transformation from early oil-based economies to today's diversification and rapid population growth, examined the campaign for women's suffrage in our country in History lessons as well as studying themes of peace and conflict and how different religions view these issues in Religious Education.

Equally, our KS4 students have been working exceptionally hard, with historians analysing the events and impacts of 1066 and beyond. In Geography Year 10s have completed a study on the Malaysian rainforest while Year 11s have finished their case study of Rio de Janeiro as a newly emerging economy. In Religious Studies, Year 10 students have been examining the Christian ideas around atonement and salvation, whilst Year 11 are about to start their new topic Religion, crime and punishment. Year 11 students are also busy preparing for their upcoming PPEs and we are looking forward to celebrating their progress with them.


