

Information for Results Day 2022

Dear Year 11

On Thursday 25th August 2022 you can collect your GCSE results.

We are very much looking forward to seeing you and celebrating your results with you.

Please, when you come in to collect your results, return any GCSE textbooks or resources that you have borrowed during your GCSEs. This is so important to help the school, as it means we do not have to buy new resources and can support students better.

On the Day - 9.00 am all students can collect their results

Results will be available to collect from the Sports Hall. Upon arrival to school, we ask that students enter via the main gate entrance and walk to the front of the Sport Hall where you will collect your results envelopes. Please enter the Sports Hall via the first fire door, next to the front entrance. Parents and family members are welcome to wait on the tennis courts. Please ensure you bring identification with you to collect your results.

We ask that students then open their envelopes outside on the tennis courts (weather permitting) so that we can keep numbers inside to a minimum.

Students who are not able to collect their results should email exams@barnwood-park.gloucs.sch.uk so alternative arrangements can be made. Please note we require written permission from the student for someone to collect results on their behalf.

Review of Marking

Every year, many students nationally, miss out on a higher grade by only a few marks. Barnwood Park is committed to ensuring our students achieve the best grade possible and as such we review your marks against the grade boundaries for each subject. If we feel that there is a chance that your grade could go up we may approach you on results day to obtain written permission to request a review of marking on your behalf. If we recommend a review of marking there would be no cost to you. In all other instances, costs would need to be paid up front as per the information overleaf.

Post-Results Services

The Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) has issued guidance on this years' post-results services. The Examination Boards have rigorous checks to ensure that their marking and grading procedures are of the highest standards. If a mistake is made it is invariably detected and corrected well before results are published.

However, if you feel that you have been awarded a grade which is inexplicable and you would like to query it, you may request that the Examination Board checks your marks. It is advisable beforehand that you speak to the Subject Leader who will give you guidance as to whether you should proceed.

The following levels of checking can be requested, **costs are refunded only if the grade is improved.**

Service 1 – Clerical Re-check

This service is available to check that all parts of the script have been marked; the totalling of the marks and the recording of the marks. This service is unlikely to result in a change of grade.

Service 2 – Review of Marking

This service is a review of the original marking to ensure the mark scheme has been applied correctly. Scripts are NOT remarked but a review of the existing marking is undertaken.

Please note that for some subjects there may be more than one unit to be checked. The costs above apply to each unit.

ALL requests must be made by Barnwood Park School to the awarding body and will not be accepted directly from the student. Written consent must be given using the appropriate form obtained from the Exams Officer prior to any request being made. Failure to obtain written consent is classed as malpractice under JCQ regulations.

The closing date for applications for either Service 1 or 2 is 12pm on Monday 19th September 2022. If you wish to submit an enquiry please come into school, between 9am and 2.30pm to see the Exams Officer, Mrs Swain or email exams@barnwood-park.gloucs.sch.uk. An appointment will be made for you to come in to school and complete the enquiry form. Full payment will be requested upon completion of the form.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND THAT YOUR GRADE CAN GO DOWN, UP OR STAY THE SAME. CAREFUL CONSIDERATION SHOULD BE TAKEN PRIOR TO REQUESTING A REVIEW OF MARKING.
