COVID-19

Like us, I'm sure you're keen that your children remain in school this academic year and we want to remind you to please continue to use lateral flow tests on a Sunday and Wednesday (twice weekly) and record the results on the links below. Please inform school of the test result using this link. http://bit.ly/studentcovidtestresults

You will also need to log the test results with the NHS via the gov.uk website as well. <u>https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result</u>

Students who test positive in either of their lateral flow tests **should not attend school** and will need to isolate for 10 days and book a PCR test to confirm the positive result. If your child is unable to attend school, please inform school using <u>attendance@barnwood-park.gloucs.sch.uk.</u>

Reports and Parents Evenings

KS3 reports will be sent home twice a year, in Term 3 and Term 6. Both reports will show progress in each of their subjects and tutor comments. There will be no subject comments in KS3. Over the next few weeks students will have assessments in English, Maths and Science, called GL Assessments, to give us information about what they know and can do already. They will also have reading assessments. It is important that students try their best in these assessments. The outcomes will help teachers and the school to meet the needs of students better, and because these assessments will be repeated later in the year, we can measure the progress each student makes in Year 7. Reports will also include information of GL Assessment outcomes.

Parents' Evenings:

Year 7: Tutor Evening in Term 1, all Subject Teachers Parent's Evening Term 5 (May).

Year 7 students will be having a Parents' Evening meeting with their tutor during the weeks of 4th and 11th October to discuss their start at Secondary school. This is a great chance to let us know how you feel your child is settling in and ask any questions that may have arisen during the first month.

This will be using the SchoolCloud online parents' evening software, which is web-based and can be accessed via phone or computer. Details about how to create your account and make an appointment at a time to suit you during the weeks of 4th to 11th October will be sent soon.

We expect Parents' Evenings to remain online at least until Christmas with COVID cases remaining high to help maintain safety of parents, students and staff.

Leaving school

A reminder that school finishes for KS3 at 2.55pm. I would ask when collecting your child at the end of the day that you consider our local community and reflect our 3 Guiding Principles of 'Show respect for others, do acts of kindness and live without harming others'. Please do not park on the zigzags as they are there for the safety of our students, or in front of driveways to allow access to residents, please slow down and maintain an appropriate speed to keep people safe. We understand that the traffic is busier at present with less people wanting to risk public transport in COVID times and as parents you want to see your child's first few days at school, but please where possible, encourage them to walk or cycle to school. If you are collecting them from school, please use the other pick up points to reduce congestion such as York Road (left out of the alley access), Coney Hill Rugby Club or the church or arboretum parking.

The Canteen

We have been informed that a few Y7 students have struggled to get food at lunch with busy queues. We have added extra staff and senior students to duty teams to support this, improved signage to make systems clearer and allowed Y7 students to start lunch 5 minutes earlier from this week, to have early access to collect their food.
