## **Advanced Information for GCSEs**

Yesterday saw the release of Advance Information for GCSEs. Our Heads of Department and teachers have been looking at this and your child may already know about some of the changes affecting their examinations.

The main purpose of this Advance Information is to help students have a better idea of the content for the examinations in recognition of the impact of the pandemic on education for students taking exams in summer 2022. The information includes the topics that will be in the exam and should therefore be used by all students to focus the revision in each subject in these areas.

In upcoming lessons, teachers will be focussing revision lessons with these changes in mind.
