 Requirements: Packed lunch or money for food and drinks throughout the day, suitable clothing and footwear. Spending money.


Information about the day:

Create your own books for toddlers and young children. Teach them about things such as numbers and colours through stories and be creative with your designs: pop-up, treasure hunt, the choice is yours.






Geometric Art
