All students at Barnwood Park are expected to comply with the dress code and take pride in their appearance. School uniform makes a considerable contribution towards the school's ethos and image within the community.

We thank parents/carers in advance for actively supporting our school uniform expectations. The school will continually monitor the quality of students' uniform and encourage students to develop a sense of pride in themselves.

Barnwood Park uniform provides students with many positive advantages, because uniform:

- Diminishes the social exclusion of students based on what they are wearing
- Places stronger focus on academic performance
- Reduces tension as students do not have to compete with their peers for the latest trends in clothes
- Creates an atmosphere of teamwork
- Encourages pride in personal appearance and of the school
- Makes them ambassadors for Barnwood Park in the local community.

Students are expected to wear full Barnwood Park uniform on the way to and from school.

Uniform

General Rules:

The school blazer should be worn at all times. A jumper or cardigan cannot be worn in place of the blazer unless instructed by the Headteacher during extreme temperatures. All items must be clearly marked with the owner's name. Hoodies should not be worn at all during the school day

No more than two pairs of small studs in each ear may be worn. No bars or spacers are allowed. No other jewellery is permitted. Any other jewellery worn will be confiscated and returned only to a parent, or at the end of term to the student. For reasons concerned with safety, other forms of facial, tongue or body piercing are not acceptable in school and will not be permitted in school at any time.

No excessive make-up or nail-varnish should be worn to school under any circumstances. For safety reasons **no acrylic nails should be worn to school.**

All hair accessories/adornments must be navy blue in colour.

Hairstyles should be tidy and inconspicuous – long hair should be tied back during PE or practical lessons. No extreme styles or unnatural hair colours are allowed.

Please note that any student is permitted to wear whichever version of the school uniform that they feel most comfortable in.

School Uniform Grant

Pupils from low-income families (using free school meals eligibility) transferring to secondary education in September (i.e. into Year7) from Primary to Secondary school are entitled to support with their uniform costs, this is administered by the school.

The grant is paid as a contribution toward the cost of your child's school uniform. Successful applications will be issued with a voucher that can be redeemed at Monkhouse Schoolwear, 99 Northgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2AA (stockist of our school uniform). The voucher may be used to buy any item of clothing that is on your child's compulsory uniform list.

The grant is a one off payment and does not have to be paid back. However, if it is found that a grant has been claimed fraudulently then we will require the full amount of the grant to be returned.

Once you have filled out your application form, you will need to return it to the Finance Office. Applications will be processed within 5 to 10 working days. If you are entitled to a grant, you will receive a letter confirming this and the value of the voucher: the voucher should follow within 1 to 2 weeks of that letter. Applications are available from the April prior to the September that your child transfers from Primary to Secondary school.

Second Hand Uniform

Uniform Loan:

The school also holds a selection of uniform that will be loaned to a student if they arrive in school wearing any item of uniform that is incorrect.

Equipment

As well as uniform Barnwood Park expects all students to arrive at school with the necessary equipment to allow them to engage in learning. Equipment will be monitored through our Registration and Tutor Time.

Students who regularly arrive late and without equipment or uniform will lead to the school making contact with parents/carers to discuss the situation and the impact it is having on their child's engagement and progress.
